Applicants that have been conditional approved will be provided with further information, including a contract for accessing Texas vehicle title and registration records. Payment should not be submitted with this application at this time.

Applicants applying on behalf of a business or entity must be at executive management level (i.e. Owner, President, CEO, CIO, etc.). Your signature and a copy of your current government issued photo ID are required with this application to certify the statements are true and correct. A copy of the business or entity state-issued professional license is required as requested on attachment A for permitted use selected. Sole Proprietorships must provide a copy of their Assumed Name Certificate, if applicable.
